

**Terms and conditions of purchasing and using entry tickets to the Energylandia Family Amusement Park in Zator**

**– during the period of existence of the legislation or sanitary guidelines relating to the prevention and combating of COVID-19**

**“Safety Guidelines in connection with COVID-19”**

1. All persons entering the premises of the Energylandia Amusement Park are obliged to read these Safety Guidelines in connection with COVID-19 and follow them.
2. It is understood that:
  - a) Bylaws for the Guests of the Energylandia Family Amusement Park in Zator remain in force, taking into account the Safety Guidelines in connection with COVID-19, including those associated with the replacement of the stamps specified in point 11 of the said Bylaws with special bands.
  - b) The policies of using the water zone at the Energylandia Amusement Park remain in force, taking into account the Safety Guidelines in connection with COVID-19, **including the Guest number restrictions in the water zone arising from legal regulations** applicable to swimming pools.
3. It is understood that the entry to the Energylandia Amusement Park as well as using its attractions and infrastructure is only allowed on the basis of policies arising from the current legislation, guidelines and recommendations of relevant ministries and the Chief Sanitary Inspectorate (including individual decisions/recommendations of sanitary inspectorates) – appropriate for an Amusement Park, and in regards to the water zone at the Amusement Park appropriate for swimming pools.
4. As described in point 3 above, the guidelines and recommendations are (may be) published and amended on an ongoing basis by the relevant state institutions (e.g. due to the so-called 'softening' of restrictions) due to the current epidemiological situation in Poland, the Energylandia Amusement Park shall make every effort to publish these guidelines and recommendations on our website and in front of the entrance to the Energylandia Amusement Park, immediately after their release (such information can also be obtained by calling the Energylandia Amusement Park's info-line).
5. The Energylandia Amusement Park may be subject to some stricter sanitary/safety restrictions than those presented in the guidelines and recommendations mentioned in point 3 above, in which case it will present them in the manner described in point 4 above.
6. An individual intending to enter the premises of the Energylandia Amusement Park on a given day should read the information regarding the above-mentioned recommendations, guidelines, and restrictions the day before (in the event they had such intention on the day of ticket purchasing, they should do the above prior to the purchase) and follow them.
7. Due to the state of epidemic caused by the SARS-CoV-2 virus infections it is hereby set forth that, **in compliance with applicable laws, entry to the Energylandia Amusement Park shall be denied to all persons subject to isolation, mandatory quarantine, or epidemiological supervision, including persons being infected with SARS-CoV-2, persons suspected of being infected with SARS-CoV-2 and persons coming into contact with the above persons during the period indicated in the legislation.** Therefore, entry to the Energylandia Amusement Park by a given person constitutes their declaration that, to the best of their knowledge, they do not pose a risk to the health or life of others due to SARS-CoV-2 (in the case of a child under 13 years of age the person responsible for the care of the child is an adult person who is obliged to supervise the child).
8. The Energylandia Amusement Park shall be entitled to the verification and enforcement of the Safety Guidelines in connection with COVID\_19, in a manner prescribed by the law, or above-mentioned recommendations and guidelines as well as the contract entered into with the Guest. Refusal of the client's consent to the above verification, if it will require the client's consent under the law, may justify - for the sake of protection of the health of other persons - refusal to provide the service by the Park (denial of admission to the Park, or asking the Guest to leave the premises). The refusal of service provision by the Energylandia Amusement Park is also possible in a justified case involving the observation of worrying symptoms suggesting infection with the SARS-CoV-2 virus (coronavirus) in a Guest, unless it is established in a legal manner that these symptoms are not related to the aforementioned virus.



9. The Energylandia Amusement Park clarifies that the obligation to cover one's mouth and nose, as well as to keep an appropriate social distance - applies under the rules resulting from the regulations in force at the time, including the regulations of the Council of Ministers on the establishment of certain restrictions, orders and prohibitions in connection with the occurrence of an epidemic - where (until further notice in whole or in part in the manner described in paragraph 4 above) the following has been established: **the principle of covering the mouth and nose with a mask (mask) in the area of: entrances to the attractions/devices, while using the attractions/devices (including inside them) and in the show areas - due to safety rules related to the use of the attractions/devices and other persons using the attractions/devices and sanitary considerations.** Due to the above safety considerations, it is not allowed to cover your mouth and nose with anything other than a mask (mask) or parts of your wardrobe when using the attractions/devices (including inside them), Due to the above safety considerations, it is not allowed to cover your mouth and nose with anything other than a mask (mask) or parts of your wardrobe when using the attractions/devices (including inside them), (i.e. it is not allowed to cover the mouth and nose with: clothing, including shawls, scarves; parts of clothing; visors; protective helmets, as referred to in the Traffic Law). Due to the above described safety reasons, persons who cannot cover their mouth and nose with a mask - for the duration of the above described rule of covering their mouth and nose with a mask - may not be located in the area described above, including attractions/devices subject to the above described rule, however, the above does not apply to children under 4 years of age. Prior to the purchase of an entry ticket to the Amusement Park, for a person who cannot cover their mouth or nose, it is advised to consider whether the person buying those tickets consents to the abovementioned conditions. Information on the currently applicable rules resulting from legal regulations in the above mentioned scope will be available in the manner described in point 4 above.
10. It is understood the purchase of an entry ticket to the Energylandia Amusement Park does not constitute a space reservation at the water zone of the Energylandia Amusement Park (the zone subject to the said limit is marked accordingly in the Park). Due to legal regulations introduced, the number of people who can use the water zone at the same time is limited - it is understood that access to this zone may be limited (which may result in a longer wait time for an entry to this zone of the Energylandia Amusement Park), and it may even prove impossible on that specific day (if the statutory limit of people using that zone at the same time does not allow it). It is also understood that the remaining rides/attractions in the Energylandia Amusement Park shall remain at the Guests' disposal.
11. It is understood that during the period of these guidelines being in force, due to the sanitary requirements - referred to above - there may be a longer waiting time for access to individual rides/attractions of the Energylandia Amusement Park. In a situation like this, queues to a given ride/attraction may require a wait time longer than 60 minutes, and the data on a given ride/attraction of the Energylandia Amusement Park may be unavailable (the Energylandia Amusement Park shall keep its Guests up-to-date on any rides/attractions that may be unavailable on a given day/period. The information shall be posted in the manner described in point 4 above (such information may also be obtained by calling the Park's info-line).
12. These Safety Guidelines in connection with COVID-19 shall be in force from 9 June 2020 until further notice.
